### PROJECT REPORT

### **AUDIO/VISUAL EQUIPMENT FUND**

As most of you know, the church voted to proceed with the entire Audio/Visual Project, which will cost \$33,125.87.

A check has been sent to Voight Enterprises for the down-payment on June 7, 2021. On June 13, 2021, we collected \$7,360.00 as our offering for this project. We have \$6,774.86 left in the Rally Day 2014, which was applied to this project in 2014, which gave us a total of \$13,134.86. (We have already raised 42% of what we need.) That leaves us with a balance of \$18, 991.01.

Many thanks to all those who contributed. Praise God from whom all blessings flow!

We will continue to take donations for this project, and the church will be informed as we move through this process.
