# CHURCH LEADERSHIP REPORT

## Town Hall Meeting 05-17-2026

Our congregation came together on May 17, 2026, for a Town Hall meeting for prayerful discussion about the future of our church. We had 30 in attendance, plus 7 Leadership Team members for a total of 37. John Sawyer from Middle District Baptist Association came to help us navigate questions and concerns. All of us feel the Town Hall was a success.

John Sawyer suggested that we take a step back and not panic. That we use this time as a reflective process to see where we are going and where we have been. Lyndale needs to figure out who we are as a church. We, as a congregation, need to seek Jesus and unity more than anything else. Our church belongs to God, and we need to keep Him in the forefront of any decisions we make as a church.

### **Some of the things we need to be praying for are:**

- Wisdom, discernment and unity for our church leadership.
- Encouragement for staff and volunteers.
- Healing for anyone carrying disappointment or hurt.
- Continued faithfulness to the mission of Lyndale Baptist Church.
- Good counsel from outside sources to navigate change and transition.
- Celebrating the good things that are happening.

During the meeting, we invited questions and discussion about what the congregation would like to see moving forward. These conversations raised the following ideas and questions:

- A Full-Time Pastor interested in Pastoral Care.
- A Pastor that would connect with our Congregation and its needs.
- A Pastor interested in Evangelism and connect with the community – Outreach, change and compromise are important.
- Congregation to be involved in building the church before the next pastor comes.·A season of renewal and revival for Lyndale.
- We should prepare a profile for Lyndale to present to applicants – demographics, history and community.
- How does our Vision for Lyndale fit going forward?
- When the time is right, a Pastor Search Team will be voted on by the congregation, and they will take on the responsibility of the search for a pastor.

Lyndale Baptist Church has been a light in the community for over 60 years and we want to continue to shine that light, the Light of Jesus. We need to be bold for Christ.
